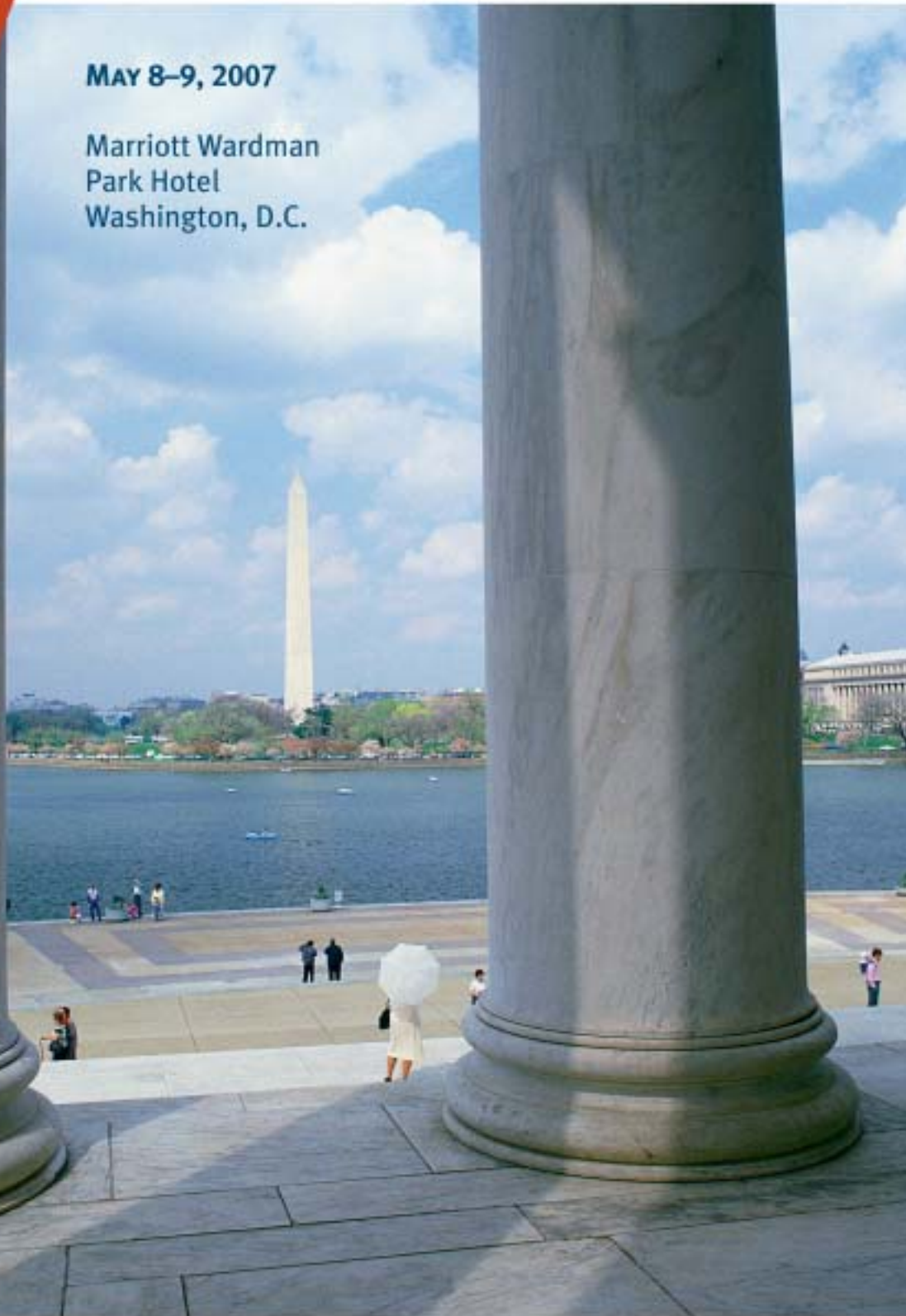

## *Transportation Investment for a Strong Economy*

However, current Highway Trust Fund revenue may not be sufficient to fund SAFETEA-LU guaranteed highway investment levels. With a zero Highway Trust Fund Highway Account balance looming in the near future, some could push for significant cutbacks in Federal surface transportation investments as early as this year. The transportation construction industry cannot afford to wait until a crisis hits. Now is the time to begin educating the new Congress about the need to increase revenue into the Highway Trust Fund to support needed transportation improvements in every state and congressional district.
