The federal transportation programs are truly at a cross roads. There are a number of critical decisions Congress must make in 2008 that will impact the ultimate direction these programs take.

Highway Trust Fund revenue is projected to be insufficient to meet the authorized funding level for Fiscal Year 2009, resulting in a possible cut in federal funds for state highway programs of anywhere from 10 to 35 percent. SAFETEA-LU expires September 30, 2009, but the reauthorization debate is already underway on Capitol Hill. The outcome of these deliberations will likely define the future of the federal highway and transit construction programs and how they are financed. The federal aviation programs remain in limbo with a new authorization bill now five months overdue.

The transportation construction industry cannot afford to sit back and wait for Washington to act. Now is the time to begin educating your senators and representative about transportation needs in your state and the important issues that will come before them this year.
